JR/SR HIGH STUDENTS



Series: Looking Forward Living with a Thankful Heart Text: Ephesians 5:18-20

Ephesians 5:18-20 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. <u>Instead, be filled with the Spirit</u>, speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and <u>make music from your heart</u> to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Worship: Ps. 92:1 It is good to praise the Lord and make music to his name, to proclaim his love in the morning and his faithfulness at night.

Where do you have a deep sense of gratitude to God for everything?

Who taught you how to be thankful and grateful?

Endless Thanks! Eph 5:20 ...always giving thanks to God the Father for everything.

Recognize, God is your source. James 1:17. Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

What is the opposite of being grateful? Murmuring, griping, complaining and ingratitude.

Everything comes through Christ. Eph 5:20 ...giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Hindrances to living with a grateful heart.

- 1. Pride
- 2. A critical spirit
- 3. False expectations
- 4. Spiritual amnesia

The Trifecta of Thankfulness: Colossians 2:7 rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Colossians 4:2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

Be Happy, don't worry. I Thess. 5:16-18 Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Ingratitude stifles the work of the Holy Spirit. 1Thess. 5:19-21 Do not quench the Spirit. Do not treat prophecies with contempt but test them all; hold on to what is good,

Be grateful, Be thankful, Be an encourager, Be a blessing...

Make a list of things you are thankful for and people you need to thank.
