The Greatest Story EVER!

Key Verse: "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work." **2 Timothy 3:16-17**

The three lenses of understanding the Bible:

- The Story: what is the plot?
- The Strategy: what is the plan?
- The Specifics: what is the process?

Responsible Bible interpretation always considers the <u>story</u>, <u>strategy</u> and <u>specifics</u> of the Bible.

Today's focus: The Story

What is the plot of the Bible, and how do we get it wrong?

- We confuse what God's goal is.
- We mix God's story with human stories.
- We focus so much on the details that we forget the main point.
- We've never been properly taught.

The plot in Colossians 1:13-14 (NIV):

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

The Greatest Story EVER plays out in the Bible like a five-act play:

- Act 1: Creation: How the World Got the Way it Is (Genesis 1-11)
- Act 2: Israel: God's People for the World (Genesis 12-Malachi)
- Act 3: The Messiah: The New Adam (The Gospels)
- Act 4: The Church: The New Global Israel -Jews & Gentiles Together (Acts-Rev)
- Act 5: Our Turn: The History of the Church

NOW WHAT?

As God's "change agents" called by the Father, commissioned by Jesus and empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are to <u>announce</u> and <u>demonstrate</u> the kingdom of God. We are to play our part in God's big story and obediently enact God's strategy, while being shaped, informed, and corrected by the richness of God's Word.
